

# SB 2042 Fifth Year Clear Credential Program

Our **SB 2042 Fifth Year Clear Credential** program is designed for public, charter, and private school teachers who are employed in districts that do not offer an Induction program. Applicants must hold a valid preliminary SB 2042 credential and provide a CL-855 form *Verification of Unavailability of a Commission-Approved Induction Program* signed by their employing agency.

## The Program Provides:

- The required Advanced Areas of Study courses
- A planned course of study and additional coursework to meet the 45 quarter unit requirement
- Student advisement and clear credential recommendation to CCTC upon completion of program requirements

## Courses Offered to Clear a California Teaching Credential

The courses listed below are approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing to fulfill the requirements for most single and multiple subject teaching credentials.
