When to Begin

We recommend beginning in Fall or Spring if you plan to take one course per quarter. You may take [Biostatistics](#) and [SAS Programming I](#) concurrently. If you choose to do this, we recommend beginning in Winter or Summer.

What is Required

There are four required courses in the [Biostatistics certificate](#). You must take the program courses in the order listed in the chart below, which shows when and in what format courses are offered.

- You must pass *both* [Biostatistics](#) and [SAS Programming I](#) prior to enrolling in [Biostatistical Methods I](#).
- You must pass *both* [SAS Programming I](#) and [Biostatistical Methods I](#) prior to enrolling in [Biostatistical Methods II](#).

How Long It Takes

Most students complete the program in one year by taking one course per quarter for four consecutive quarters. You may take [Biostatistics](#) and [SAS Programming I](#) concurrently to complete the program in less than one year. You have up to five years to complete all requirements for the certificate.
