A) Do I need to arrive on time for my program to complete registration?

Yes, you must arrive at least one day before the published program start-date. Students who arrive after 4:00pm on the published start-date of the program must pay a late arrival fee of \$200 USD.

B) Do I need a student visa (F-1) to attend your programs?

If your <u>main intent</u> in coming to the U.S. is to study, you should apply for a student visa. If you are coming to the U.S. <u>mainly for tourism</u>, and you also want to take English classes for your own pleasure or as recreation, then a tourist visa (B-2) or Visa Waiver (WT) is appropriate. If you are not sure whether study or tourism is your main intent, explain your plans to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate in your country and they will advise you on the appropriate visa to apply for.
