

# ART 40661: Playing with Pen & Ink Materials List

## Supply List

If you have supplies that are similar, bring them in and we can see if they will work for what we are doing.

- 1, 4B graphite pencil
- White colored pencil
- Speedball Dip Pens for sketching (set comes with two handles and an assortment of nibs. Do not get the calligraphy set.)
- Black ballpoint pen (BIC is fine)
- Black fine point (Rotring, Micron, Faber Castel are all good. 01, 03 and 05 are good)
- Waterproof India ink in a bottle
- Plastic container, with lid (A big butter container would be fine)
- Faber Castel, dust free, eraser
- Xacto knife w/ blades (utility knife will also work)
- 1 metal, 12" ruler, cork on back if possible
- 1, portfolio or cardboard, folded over, big enough to hold your 9" x 12" paper
- Pencil sharpener (Electric or battery operated if possible)
- A box for your supplies. A shoebox is fine or you can get a fancy case.

### Paper:

- About 5"x 8" sketchpad, white paper, for notes and sketches (you can go bigger if you prefer)
- Pad of paper, 9"x12" (Bristol is good. Smooth and Vellum are your choices. I'm ok with either, or you can get paper specifically for inking. Borden and Riley #234, bleedproof is good.)
- 1 sheet of dark grey Canson paper, 18" x 24" ("Steel grey", "Flannel grey" or "Felt grey" is fine)
