

Previous Ryan and 5th Year of Study Program Requirements

(New candidates must apply to the current Induction Program)

Per Commission policies, Ryan and 5th Year of Study programs have sunsetted and can no longer admit new candidates. If you were admitted to a Ryan or 5th Year of Study program at another institution and would like to take courses offered by UC San Diego to complete these requirements, please refer to the grid below for available classes. If you have not been admitted to a program at another institution, then you should apply to the current Induction Program offered at Extension.

The UCSD [Induction](#) program is designed for public, charter, and private school teachers who are employed in districts that do not offer an Induction program. Applicants must hold a valid preliminary single subject, multiple subject, or education specialist credential and Employment Verification signed by their employing agency.

Courses offered under the previous Ryan and 5th Year program requirements.

The courses listed below are approved by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing to fulfill the requirements for most single and multiple subject teaching credentials under the previous program standards.
