

## Prerequisites for Preliminary Single & Multiple Subject Credential Programs

While UC San Diego Extension does not offer a program to earn your Preliminary Single & Multiple Subject Teaching Credential, we do offer courses recommended by many preliminary programs to fulfill the prerequisite requirements of their Preliminary Single and Multiple Subject Teaching Credential programs.

In order to fulfill your Preliminary Single and Multiple Subject Credential prerequisite requirements, you may take the coursework at UC San Diego Extension. It is strongly advised that you verify the required coursework with the institution you plan to earn your Preliminary Single and Multiple Subject Credential.
